### **How to take advantage of the FOP 44/NPCU Loan**

- \* Complete the FOP 44 membership process or be a current FOP44 Member
- \* Go to [nationalpolicecu.com](http://nationalpolicecu.com) and click on the member application link located in the "Become a Member" section at the bottom of the web page
- \* Be sure to note your five digit account number (ignore the zeroes in front of the account number) that you will receive near the end of the application process.
- \* For the signature card, you will need to fill in the Payable on Death (POD) Account information, check the "Exempt" box (unless you owe the IRS back taxes), sign and date the card and then scan and email it to [Lhernandez@cpdfcu.com](mailto:Lhernandez@cpdfcu.com)
- \* Go to the website home page and click on the "Apply for a Loan" tab
- \* Select "Personal Loan" from the drop down menu
- \* It will prompt you to enter your "Member Number" which is your five digit account number you received while joining the credit union
- \* It will then prompt you to enter your birth date and social security number
- \* You will then enter your email and a password, should you need to logout and return to the application later
- \* Finish the loan application process
- \* Once NPCU receives your loan application, they will process it and send you your loan paperwork via a secured online portal for you to electronically sign and return
- \* Upon receipt of the electronically signed paperwork, NPCU will deposit the funds into your account
- \* You can then access those funds from any of NPCU's shared branching locations. There are 136 Shared Branching locations in Arizona. You can also use one of the 68 "V-Coms" located at any 7-Eleven store. To find the nearest shared branching location to you, click on the "Hours and Locations" tab on the National Police Credit Union website and click "Location Finder". Select "Shared Branch" from the drop down box and put in your zip code. You will need your five digit account number, along with a valid government issued ID (driver's license, state ID or passport). Let them know you are a member of Chicago Patrolmen's FCU, the parent company of NPCU. There are no fees associated with doing basic transactions at a Shared Branch location.
